Harry Meyering Center opened in 1973 in response to the concerns parents had for their adult children who have intellectual disabilities. They wanted their children to be able to be well supported in the community and to lead safe and meaningful lives. Today, HMC serves over 150 people in the Mankato area in settings that support their individual needs.
