Since 1995, VINE Faith in Action has coordinated volunteers and services that assist neighbors of all ages facing difficult life situations. VINE staff members interact daily with older adults challenged by caregiving, living with a chronic disease, limited mobility, isolation, and other threats to physical and mental health. VINE provides older adults with wrap-around services: chores, transportation, peer mentoring, friendly visits, meals on wheels, loaned durable medical equipment, and caregiver support including transition home, social model and in-home volunteer respite, and coaching and support groups.



At the VINE Adult Community Center (VACC), VINE offers high quality programs and resources to encourage healthy aging throughout the life span. We know that when people are encouraged and supported in caring for their health, they will have a much greater chance of enjoying independent living well into their later years. At the VACC, adults “in mid-life and beyond” enjoy a wide-array for fitness opportunities, educational trips and programs, and opportunities to socialize and volunteer their time helping others. VINE’s quarterly newsletter is posted on our website. A sliding fee scale is in place to assure that adults with limited income can participate.



VINE’s funding comes from grants, contributions, earned income, and proceeds from the VINE Home Thrift Store. Our successful store accepts donations of clean, gently-used home furnishings and accessories and sells them at great prices to the community.
