Habitat for Humanity is a non-profit Christian Housing Ministry dedicated to building simple, decent, and affordable homes with and for families in need.



- Habitat for Humanity works in partnership with people in need living in inadequate housing to build family housing with tax-deductible donations, using volunteers and skilled labor. Homes are sold at cost of materials, interest free, to qualifying families in need. The house payments are used to build even more homes within the communities we serve. Mortgages are typically \$550 to \$600 per month, including taxes and insurance.
- Families selected for the program are required to volunteer 200 to 400 hours of construction or “sweat equity” during the building process. Volunteers are truly the backbone of Habitat. By working together homeowners, families, volunteers, and donors become partners in the work of building houses. In the process, they are also building new relationships within the community.
- Habitat for Humanity of South Central Minnesota was founded in Mankato in 1990, expanded to include the St. Peter chapter in 1993, the Le Sueur chapter in 1999, and the Watonwan County chapter in 2009. As of 2016, our affiliate has built 119 homes, averaging 6 to 8 homes per year.

The Habitat ReStore opened in 2007. The ReStore accepts donations of new and gently used building materials, and then sells them to the public to raise funds for affordable housing in the community. The ReStore diverts over 200 tons of building material away from area landfills each year. Plans are underway to expand our ReStore. Construction will begin in the Spring of 2016.
